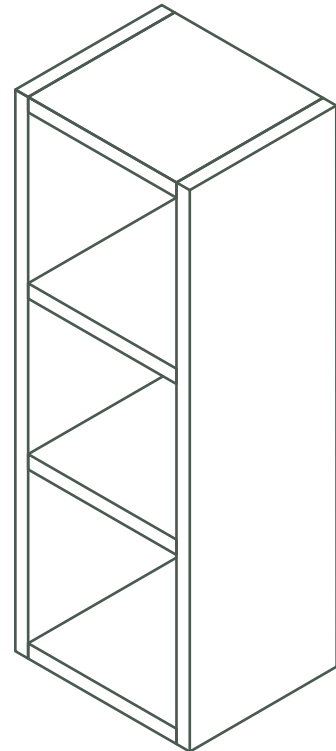
TOOLS REQUIRED

- Rubber Mallet / Dead Blow Hammer

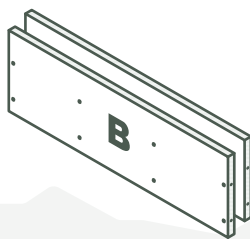

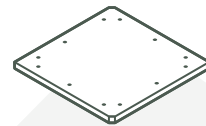

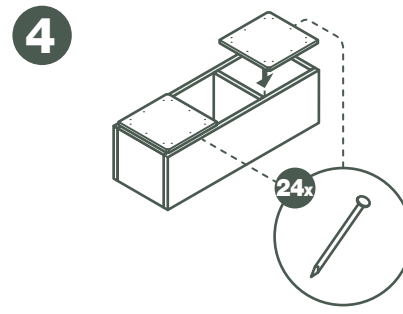
Insert connectors (16) into holes of Fixed Shelves (A)



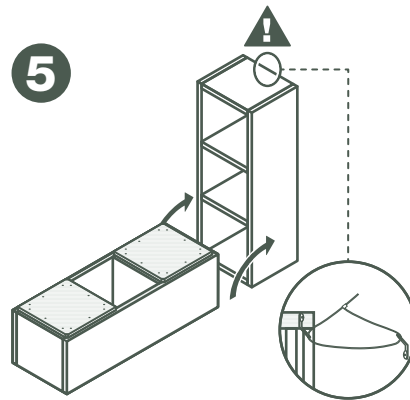
Align holes of Side Panels (B) with the inserted connectors in the Fixed Shelves (A)



Ensure Side Panels (B) are aligned properly prior to securing Fixed Shelves (A). Connect shelves using a rubber mallet / dead blow hammer. Verify connectors are aligned to the holes of Side Panels (B) as the connection is made. Failure to align connectors may damage and/or weaken the connection.



Use a hammer to fasten Back Panels to the organizer with the included nails



Tilt organizer upright and secure to wall using the included anti-tip hardware. Failure to secure to wall may create an unsafe tipping hazard
